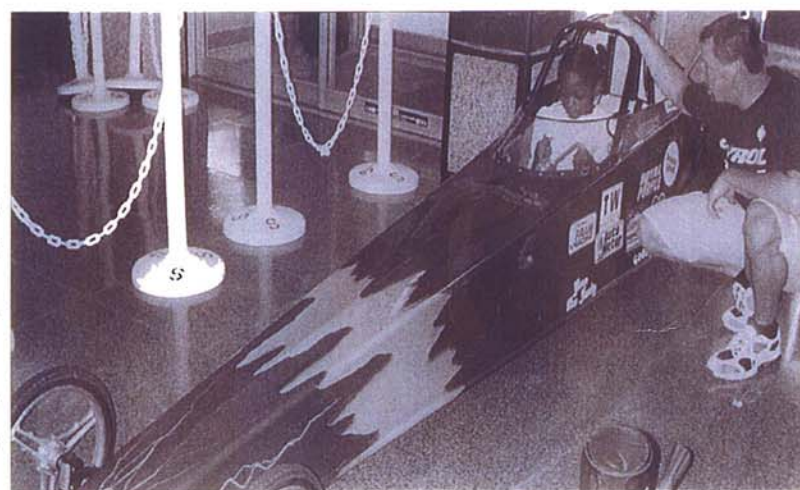


Patients get thrill out of testing race cars

"I just want to see the kids get a big smile on their faces," he said.

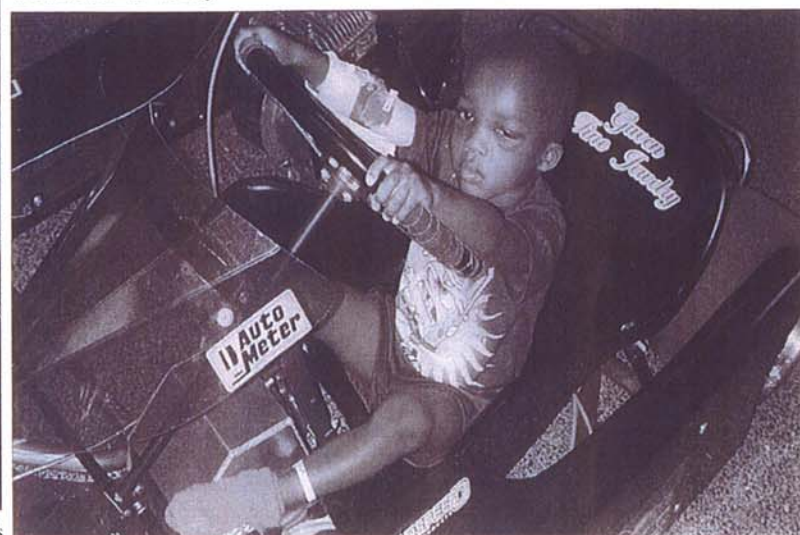

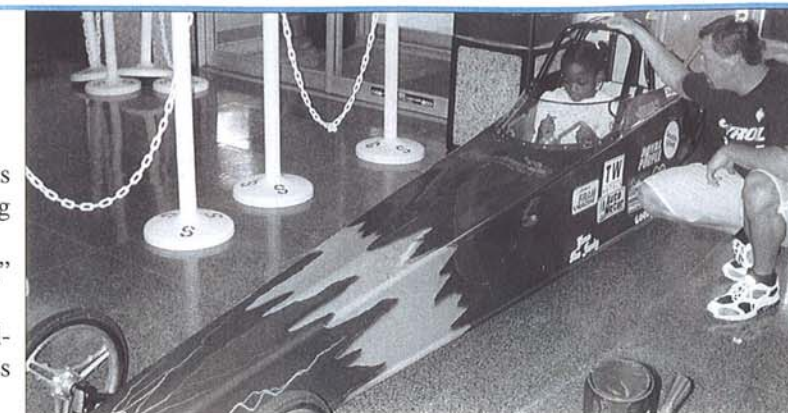
